Responsible for

The Head of Student Representatives will be responsible for:

- Contacting each Canadian University with an accredited physical therapy program for the recruitment of student representatives for the National Orthopaedic Division (NOD) of the Canadian Physiotherapy Association
- Compiling the letters of intent provided from each potential candidate, categorized by university, and presenting them to the NOD Governance Committee for approval.
- Notifying the chosen candidate and providing a document containing all relevant information regarding the roles & responsibilities of their position.
- Attending all NOD teleconferences and disseminating all relevant information to each NOD student representative so that the information may be transferred to the physical therapy student body of their respective universities
- Liaising between the National Orthopaedic Division Executive Committee & the appointed NOD Student Representative for each respective university with regards to any questions and/or concerns from either party.

Requirements

- Physiotherapist
- Previous leadership experience, motivated
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills
- Has had proven experience with student issues (eg: sat on NOD as a student representative)
